

Documentation Required for MaineCare Application

When you apply for MaineCare long term care benefits, you will need to provide the following items:

- Copies of Social Security cards
- Copies of all health insurance cards including Medicare
- Copy of birth certificate
- Green card/naturalization certificate (if not a US citizen)
- Copy of Power of Attorney, Conservator, or Guardianship documents
- Financial statements for all accounts owned by applicant and/or spouse for past 60 months
- Proof of income (all sources) and amounts
- Documentation of value of all real estate
- Copies of deeds for all real estate
- If real estate sold within 60 months, then copy of settlement statement
- Certificates of title for all vehicles and KBB value
- If vehicles sold within 60 months, then documentation of sale
- If applicant is grantor or beneficiary of trust, then copy of trust
- Copies of annuity contracts in effect over the past 60 months
- Copies of life insurance policies owned by applicant and/or spouse including cash surrender values
- Copies of prepaid burial contracts and mortuary trusts, if any
- Declaration of contents of safety deposit box(es), if any
- Copies of IRAs, 401(k), Keoghs, pensions, etc.
- Copies of savings/treasury bonds owned by applicant and/or spouse
- Documentation of values and use of all assets cashed in, closed, sold, transferred or otherwise liquidated during the 60 months prior to application.
- Signed Intent to Return Home form
- Highest school grade completed by applicant
- Whether applicant or spouse served in military
